

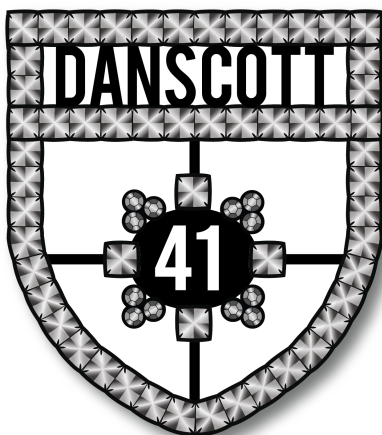

POLICY HANDBOOK FOR 2022/2023

The teachers and director will be placing dancers in their appropriate level(s). Invitations to try alternate levels will come from the teachers and studio director, only. See below, pages 2, 3 and 4 for a list of Regular Classes, Specialty Classes including Contemporary, our Sessional 3-4 year old programs and also our exciting Hip Hop/Street Jazz Sessions. We will also be continuing with an Advanced Open Ballet Class, for Higher levels of Vocational, and optional for Grade 6 and 7 Ballet. Vocational Ballet levels are also strongly encouraged, when a student is interested and capable. New this year, we are offering an "Introduction to Vocational" Program, for students in Grade 3-5 Ballet. Please email for more details.

Sure to motivate and encourage, an Adult Stretch & Strength...be sure to check this out!

Intensive students at a Junior 2B Jazz level or PI 1/2 A Jazz level and higher, must register for Technique and Progressions, with their Jazz class.

"B" levels, at a Junior 3/PI 1B Jazz and higher must also register for our Stretch & Strength Class and be registered in a full year Ballet program.

"A" Jazz levels, PI 1/2 A and higher, please note that the Stretch & Strength and a full year Ballet Program is optional.

The DS Faculty does provide in studio, private lessons, in every discipline. More information is available through the DS office.

See below for further dance class guidelines or see a Dancott teacher or office representative if you have questions. We look forward to assisting you through our registration process.

REGULAR DANCE CLASSES

JAZZ/TAP COMBO (Minis): age 4-5 years

PRE-JUNIOR JAZZ (Adapt Syllabus): age 6-7 years

PRE-JUNIOR TAP (Adapt Syllabus): age 6-7 years

TAP (Adapt Syllabus): Junior 2B to Advanced/Open Tap

JAZZ (Adapt Syllabus): Junior 2B to Int 3/Pre-Adv B Levels.

"B" Levels: Jr 2B and higher must be registered in a Technique and Progressions class. Jr 3/PI 1B and higher must also be registered in a Stretch 'n Strength class as well as a full year Ballet program. "A" Levels, PI 1/2A and higher, must be registered in a Technique and Progressions class; the Stretch & Strength and full year Ballet program is optional. DS Admin will place students in the appropriate levels.

BALLET COMBO (Minis): age 4-5 years

RAD BALLET GRADES: Pre-Primary/Primary to Grade 8

Grade 6 and 7 Ballet students are also strongly encouraged to participate in our Advanced Open Ballet Class where additional technique is taught and reinforced.

VOCATIONAL BALLET PROGRAMS: Introduction to Vocational Ballet, Intermediate, Advanced Foundation, Advanced 1, Advanced 2 (is available semi-privately/privately)

All higher Vocational levels will include a corresponding Pointe/Demi-Pointe class. Intermediate and higher must also register for a separate Advanced Open Ballet Class where additional technique is reinforced. This Advanced Open Ballet class will be mandatory and will be offered until Spring Break, 2023. This class is optional for Grade 6 and 7 ballet students, not registered in Vocational Programming. All Vocational students must also be registered in a Ballet grade unless the student has successfully completed their Grade 8, RAD exam. Choreography is not offered in the regular Vocational Classes; any extra choreography will be at the teacher's discretion and will happen outside of regular classes.

LYRICAL:

Classes will offer and explore different styles of Lyrical. The teachers will concentrate on perfecting and strengthening technique and also performance ability. An emphasis will be placed on musical interpretation and emotion. Please note that these classes will include more than one level of dancer and are available to B levels: Jr 2B and higher and A levels: PI 1/2A and higher. Students registering for Lyrical must also be registered in a yearly Ballet program at Danscott. Students will be placed in classes by their teachers and also according to age and their jazz/ballet level. Competition involvement will be determined by the teacher and studio director.

STRETCH 'N TUMBLE:

This acrobatic and stretch program is for children age 5 and up who have had limited or introductory Acro experience or who have completed our Stretch 'n Tumble programs in the past and are continuing to expand their Acro skills. These students will be introduced to acrobatics and also focus on flexibility. This class will be strictly for training purposes; choreography will not be offered.

ACROBATICS A / B :

This program is available to dedicated students who have mastered several Acro movements and who are interested in developing and perfecting their Acro skills further. Dancers must be interested in expanding their Acro knowledge in all areas. Flexibility is also a focus for these classes.

ACRO INTENSIVE:

Participation in these classes will be by invitation only from the Danscott teaching staff and studio director. Class placement will be determined after considering both age and ability. These programs will run for the entire dance year and will be sure to encourage capable students to work hard on learning new Acro and tumbling skills as well as perfecting existing tricks. Our goal is to use these skills to enhance any extra choreography that might be offered.

TECHNIQUE AND PROGRESSIONS (Junior 2B Jazz and Higher & PI 1/2A Jazz and Higher)

All tech/prog classes will inspire dancers to drastically improve their overall training by refining technique and placement necessary for their specific jazz level. Turns and jumps will also be a focus in this program. Appropriate tech/prog levels will be determined by the teachers and studio director.

ADAPT EXAM PREPARATION FOR JAZZ /TAP

These extra classes are for students in Jazz /Tap levels, who are invited by the teachers and working towards a 2022 exam. These classes will only be offered for 6-8 weeks and will be completed before our Adapt exams in late November / early December. These adapt preparation classes will be mandatory for any students who are working towards a 2022 exam. Dancers will register for these programs in late September, through the studio office. Further information will be available from your teachers when dancing starts in the fall.

SPECIALTY CLASSES AVAILABLE

Musical Theatre will be offered from September to June. Contemporary, Hip Hop/Street Jazz, Stretch & Strength and Partnering will be offered as sessions (see below for details). Your teachers will ensure proper placement in all Specialty classes. Please note that each Specialty classes will include multiple dance levels, so are generally larger than regular classes. Choreography will not be offered in the Contemporary, Hip Hop/Street Jazz, Stretch & Strength or Partnering. If any extra choreography is made available for these programs, it will be at the discretion of the teachers and studio director and will be taught outside of regular classes. Musical Theatre will involve choreography in the regular class time but competition involvement will be determined by the teacher and studio director.

A very popular Adult Stretch & Strength is relatively new to our DS programs, check out the info in the next listing "D"

A. MUSICAL THEATRE

We will be working on different Jazz styles with a focus on improving performance ability, singing and acting, through Musical Theatre. All students are required to take a Jazz class in conjunction with the Musical Theatre class. This class is offered to students starting at the Jr 2B and PI 1/2 A and as high as Int 3/Pre-Adv B, levels of Jazz. All grouping of classes will be determined by age, dance ability, experience and commitment. The musical theatre levels will be determined by the teachers and studio director and scheduled accordingly. Participation in competition will be at the discretion of the teacher and studio director.

B. HIP HOP / STREET JAZZ (This program will be offered from Sept 2022 and finishing at Spring Break, 2023.)

See a summary of class dates and times when registering; groupings of levels may be adjusted, once registration is confirmed. For our Beginner /Junior/Pre-Int Level, different Program options are also available when registering. See the separate registration form for details.

Hip Hop / Street Jazz programs continue to be exciting for Danscott! These classes are available for Beginners 6 years + or a Junior/Pre-Int level of dance. A more experienced level of Hip/Hop/Street Jazz is available for dancers at a Int 1B Jazz level and higher. Our hip hop/street classes are sure to deliver an exciting experience and will absolutely enhance your child's overall dance training. See our separate handout for more details as well as registration for dancers who are not already registered in a yearly program at Danscott.

C. CONTEMPORARY / 2 Levels (These programs will be offered from Sept 2022 to Spring Break, 2023; placement will be determined by the DS Teachers and Studio Directors)

DS will be offering 2 levels of Contemporary. Our classes will focus on different styles and techniques in Jazz with an introduction to new genres such as Open and Modern. All classes are sure to enhance a student's overall dance experience. Our Contemporary programs will also include weekly conditioning as well as exciting new combinations. Level One is available to Jr3/PI1 B by invitation, PI 1/2 A and Int 1B Jazz, and a Second level for Int 1/2B and higher. Possible competition involvement will be determined by the DS teaching team and the studio director.

D. STRETCH & STRENGTH: (This program will be offered from Sept to the Spring Break, 2023)

Body conditioning for dance.....a class that will tone and stretch muscles as a means to improve our general technique and strength. We will work on whole body conditioning that will enhance your dancer's overall performance ability. These classes will run from September, 2022 to the Spring Break, 2023. Jazz dancers in B levels, Jr 3/PI B and higher, must be enrolled in this program. This program is optional for Jr 2 B jazz students as well as any A level dancers.

We are very excited to announce that we will be continuing with an Adult class for this inspirational program. The class will follow an aerobic and muscle conditioning format, designed with adults in mind. Improve your balance, aerobic endurance, flexibility and muscle tone and join in the fun. This Adult program will run from September 2022, pause during our Winter break and then run until our DS Spring Break, 2023. Drop in rates are also available. See a separate Adult Stretch & Strength form for further information and registration.

E. PARTNERING / ADAGIO CLASS (Details of this program are to be determined.)

The emphasis for this program will be on instruction and performance experience in partnering and is sure to motivate and inspire us to reach new heights. Dancers, who will be eligible to attend these classes, will be invited by the Danscott teaching staff and studio director only. Watch for further details in early September.

SESSIONAL PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN 3-4 years

Twinkle, twinkle, little stars.....Danscott is excited to offer sessional programs for our up and coming young stars. Need some fun and fancy for your child? New and exciting steps in every session! See below for the exciting details.

For children 3-4 years, we offer a "Tiny Toes" program: a program which is a fun introduction to dance, music and body movement. An experienced, mature instructor will be teaching our classes and we are sure that they will inspire and encourage our youngest stars! Our first session will begin in Sept and the classes will be scheduled for Saturday mornings. Our second session, will begin in November, 2022 and finish by mid Dec. A winter, and early spring session will also be available in 2023 and details will be available through the Danscott Office and also on our website in late fall. See the Tiny Toes handouts for all information and note that class size is limited so don't miss out on this fun opportunity.

PROPER DANCE ATTIRE

Dancers must be properly dressed for their classes. No extra clothing such as T-shirts, sweat suits, etc., is to be worn over dance clothing. All hair must be secured back (pony tail, bun, etc.). At the teacher's discretion, any dancer who does not follow the dress code, will not be allowed to participate in their class.

JAZZ/TAP COMBO (Minis): proper body fitting dance attire, black patent tap shoes (Capezio or comparable tap shoe), ballet slippers as for Ballet Combo or Pre-Prim/Prim for Jazz section)

PRE-JUNIOR JAZZ: **Girls:** proper body-fitting dance attire; black jazz elasta booties
Boys: short sleeved T-shirt or tank, shorts or sports pants; black jazz shoes

PRE-JUNIOR TAP: **Girls:** proper body-fitting dance attire; buckle tap shoes in the caramel color (#3800 Capezio) or Bloch Showtappers (#302 / #323)
Boys: short sleeved T-Shirt or tank and shorts or sports pants; tap shoes should be black

TAP: **Boys** - short sleeved T-shirt or tank and shorts or sports pants, tap shoes should be black
Girls - proper body-fitting dance attire; see below for Girls tap shoes.

Girls Tap Shoes: **Junior 2B:** buckle tap shoes in the caramel color (# 3800 Capezio) or Bloch Showtappers(#302 / #323)
Jr 3/PI B / Int/ Adv Open: black oxford tap shoes
(lace up only; pull on tap shoes not preferred)

JAZZ: proper body-fitting dance attire; males please wear exercise clothing
Boys (all levels): black jazz elasta booties
Jr 2B, Jr 3/PIB, Girls: black jazz elasta booties (pull on oxford)
PI 1/2A Girls: black jazz elasta booties (pull-on oxfords)
Intermediate - Pre Adv Levels Girls: Appropriate jazz shoes or foot paws; check with your teacher.

***If you have a different type of tap or jazz shoe that you are currently using, please note that this is acceptable to start, but please purchase tap or jazz shoes as listed above when you are buying new ones. Questions; please check with a Danscott office representative by emailing the office.**

LYRICAL AND CONTEMPORARY: Body fitting dance attire and beige Dance Paws only.

BALLET COMBO (Minis): See the separate Ballet Attire sheet.

BALLET - PRE-PRIMARY/PRIMARY, ALL GRADES AND VOCATIONAL LEVELS: See the separate Ballet Attire sheet. **Ballet students who are not involved in our Ballet Master classes, should note that they are not required to have character skirts or character shoes, for their regular classes.**

STRETCH 'n TUMBLE / ACROBATICS A / B /ACRO INTENSIVE: Body fitting attire and bare feet. *Please note that students are required to wear full length leggings, capri length shorts or longer shorts to mid-thigh, to these classes. Hair must be secured back.

HIP HOP / STREET JAZZ: Any type of exercise wear, street runners.

STRETCH & STRENGTH: Proper dance clothing and appropriate shoes.
ADULT STRETCH & STRENGTH: any type of exercise wear and runners

DANCE EXAMS

ADAPT Tap and Jazz Exams

These exams will be scheduled for late November to early December. Dancer's who will be participating in these exams, will be chosen by their teachers. Once these students have been selected, it is the parents and students choice to participate. There will be mandatory preparation classes scheduled to help prepare for these exams. Jazz/Tap students, who are working towards an exam at the Junior- Intermediate Jazz / Tap level, must participate in the Adapt Preparation classes. A newsletter, with more exam information, will be available in the fall from your teachers or studio office, if your dancer is selected for an exam.

RAD Ballet Graded Exams

Ballet levels/grades at Danscott are scheduled for once a week. We supplement this training with second Ballet lessons, called Ballet Master classes, for dancers who are working towards the possibility of a Royal Academy Ballet Exam. There will be **ten** Ballet Master classes for Grades Two to Seven and they will be scheduled automatically at the time of registration, unless otherwise notified. The Ballet Master classes will run from Sept and finish the end of Nov (10 weeks). See the Ballet Master Class summary for a detailed outline of lessons. The Ballet Master classes will automatically appear on your class notification letter that you receive by email. **Once your registration is confirmed for these classes, withdrawals from this program, will not be accepted.**

Please note that if we choose to offer a Grade One Ballet exam in our 2022-2023 season, your teachers will communicate this and then arrangements will be made for Grade One Ballet Master classes as well.

All students and parents should note that if they choose not to participate in the Ballet Master classes, that their child will not be eligible or considered for a RAD Graded exam in 2023.

Our RAD Ballet exams will be held in early spring of 2023; further Ballet information will be made available in the fall.

REGULAR CLASS COMPETITION

Information / Policies

At Danscott, we are very proud to give many levels of dancers, which include numerous of our regular classes, the chance to participate in competition. We believe this unique opportunity is so very beneficial to the growth of all our students and has been an important building block in the success of our studio. If your child is involved in a competitive class, their participation and attendance to all competitions is **mandatory**. All information, regarding competitions, will be emailed directly to all families as well as posted on our website. Decisions regarding competition participation will be made by the teachers and studio director and is based on student dedication and involvement. We strive to offer this opportunity when we feel it will be a fun and positive experience for all. We are proud to provide award winning choreography within weekly regular classes, without extra choreography fees applying.

Attendance Policy for Competitive Students / Classes: Parents with competitive students must note that attendance to all regular classes after the Family Day weekend in February, is mandatory. DS is open on the Family Day Monday, Feb 20, and attendance to classes this day, is mandatory. Attendance leading up to and including the final two weeks before our first chosen competition is also absolutely mandatory. Please note the 2023 Spring Break dates as the 2 weeks of lessons before it, are mandatory. Failure to follow these guidelines could have your child removed from participation in our first competition, if it is in the best interest of their class and team mates. This decision will be made by the teachers and studio director and will be final. Any competition entry fees paid as well as costume fees, would be forfeited. We will also advise you of a potential Stage Rehearsal date as soon as it is available so you can track on your personal calendars. Typically, this rehearsal is scheduled immediately before or after our spring break but again, you will be notified of exact dates, in the fall.

If your child has had a poor attendance record in the past, the Danscott teachers will take a moment to chat with you at the time of registration and perhaps suggest an alternative solution. Attendance and dedication to your class or group is necessary in order to maintain our strong team philosophy.

EXTRA CHOREOGRAPHY FOR COMPETITION

All Extra Groups, Duets, Trios and Solos for any of our selected competitions, will be chosen by the teachers and studio director. All chosen participants in any extra choreography (solos/duets/trios/groups) are required to be a registered Ballet student at Danscott for the entire year as well as a registered student in the discipline of dance that they are selected for. Students, who are not able to attend a chosen Danscott competition, will not be invited to participate in any extra duets, trios, small or large group choreography. Attendance to all extra rehearsals is imperative for involved students; please note that the attendance request as stated under the Regular Class Competition heading on the previous page, also applies to all extra choreography.

All extra choreography, once selected, will be notified by an email from the studio office or contacted by a teacher, in the fall. The teachers base their decisions on attendance and involvement, dedication, performance with an emphasis on natural talent. We will do as many extra numbers as our studio space and teacher availability will allow; weekend availability from our students will be mandatory. Schedule requests will not be accepted.

Fees for extra choreography will be included in the notification letter/contract and also an understanding of commitment from all dancers, once they confirm their participation. Failure to submit extra choreography fees or to follow team policies, could result in your child being withdrawn from a competition or event or the piece of choreography entirely. An estimate for '22-'23 extra choreography fees, is available through the DS Administration.

SHOWCASE 2023 (Year End Recital)

We take pride in presenting an annual Showcase featuring our DS team. Please see our dates as listed below, and note that these are tentative pending possible restrictions, studio registration, etc.

SHOWCASE DATES: Friday and Saturday, June 9 and 10, 2023

DRESS REHEARSAL: Thursday, June 8, 2023

SHOWCASE LOCATION: University of Calgary Theatre

We present a Showcase including all the regular classes with the exception of Ballet Vocational Classes (including Demi Pointe/Pointe, Advanced Open), Technique and Progressions, Stretch 'n Tumble, Acro Intensive, Acrobatics A/ B, Hip Hop/ Street Jazz, Contemporary, Stretch & Strength and all Sessional Classes. All other regular classes must attend our Dress Rehearsal on June 8 and also participate in both performances: Friday, June 9 at 6:30 pm and Saturday, June 10 at 1:00 pm. The involvement of the extra choreography groups is determined by the Danscott management after considering the length of our Showcase. Duets, trios and solos are not included in this performance unless otherwise determined by the studio director.

DANCE COSTUMES

Please remember that we will make every attempt to keep the cost of costumes down, but we also must consider the rising cost of dance fabric and necessary supplies. We also order many costumes from the United States so our cost also depends on the value of our dollar, the cost of shipping costumes through customs and also the supply availability. Props or set pieces that may be required to enhance choreography, are also factored into costume costs. All costume information will be available for all our students in Sept/Oct. The Danscott office will be emailing more details and information as it is available, to all of our families.

SHOWCASE COSTUMES FOR REGULAR CLASSES: All costumes are chosen by the teachers. Parents are responsible for buying, altering slightly or enhancing if deemed necessary by the teacher. If you do not hand sew, please keep in mind that you may have to hire a seamstress for small alterations and consequently the price will be higher. **Approximate cost: \$100.00 - \$140.00.**

SPECIALITY / COMPETITIVE NUMBERS (Excluding Solos): These numbers usually require a more expensive costume and possibly larger props. **Approximate costume cost: \$145.00-\$250.00**

***Please note that once costumes are ordered, they will not be cancelled or refunded after October 3, 2022.**

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

Withdrawals will not be processed for any dancer withdrawing from any dance program or classes after November 30, 2022 and as outlined below, such written notice must be submitted to Danscott Studio no later than November 1, 2022. Important to note that there are no withdrawals from our Sessional programs at anytime: Hip Hop/Street Jazz, Contemporary, Stretch & Strength, Adult Stretch & Strength, Advanced Open Ballet, Ballet Master Classes and Tiny Toes. Following the above time line for other withdrawals, a one month written notice is required if a student wishes to withdraw or terminate a class or classes and reimbursement will be calculated from the 1st of the month following notice. If a dancer wishes to terminate all classes by the November deadline, a minimum of one month's written notice is also required.

Possible reimbursement will be calculated and any payments made that are not required to complete outstanding fees, will be returned. Please note that discipline deposits that are received at the time of registration are non-refundable, if students are withdrawing. Families should also note that an administration fee will be added to process any withdrawal or refund. Letters of withdrawal may be given directly to a studio representative or by email directly to the office at danscottoffice@shaw.ca

VERBAL NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

Parents should also note that there will be no refunds issued for missed classes under any circumstances. With that in mind, we would ask that all communications between parents/guardians and students and Danscott teachers and staff, both verbal and written, remain respectful. By signing and submitting your child(s) registration forms for 2022-2023, parents/guardians and students are agreeing to all Information, Policies, Procedures and Conduct Guidelines as listed in the Policy Handbook or any other DS Correspondence. Please see below for a reminder of our defining outline:

- Parents/Guardians and students agree to abide and respect all policies and procedures set forth in the Danscott Policy Handbook and all future newsletters or correspondence from Danscott.
- Parents/Guardians understand that children exhibiting inappropriate behavior will be removed from our dance classes. Parents/Guardians agree to partner with Danscott Faculty to resolve behavioral issues so their child/children can return to class promptly.
- Parents/Guardians and students are expected to respect all Danscott Faculty. Parents/Guardians will not interact with anyone at Danscott Studio in a manner that is intended to provoke hostility. All concerns should be voiced through the Danscott Office Staff and then they will organize a response from involved parties within 5 business days. Staff or director meetings could have an associated cost pending involvement required.
- Parents/Guardians must not enter the teaching space or dance studios, uninvited by the teacher or assistant at anytime; including before, during and after regular teaching hours.
- Parents/ Guardians recognize that Danscott classes operate in the safest manner by trained dance teachers and assistants.

There are dancers at the studio with potentially life-threatening allergies to peanuts and nuts. Any peanut butter or nut products are absolutely prohibited.
- Parents/Guardians will inform Danscott Faculty of any extended vacations or absences which will affect their child/children and their dance program. This is especially vital when choreography starts in late fall. Parents agree to the guideline listed under our Competition information regarding attendance to all classes or rehearsals.
- Parents/ Guardians agree to pick up their child/children in a timely fashion. Students who are left unattended after their class/classes are not the responsibility of Danscott. The studio is opened Monday- Sunday, only 20 minutes before classes. Teachers will lock up the studio within 10-15 minutes at the end of the day; students must be picked up within this time frame. Failure to pick up within the time frame could result in a fee to cover the instructor's time.
- Parent/Guardians agree to stay current on studio happenings, performances, exams and competitions.
- Parents/Guardians and students understand that it is their responsibility to locate lost items in our Lost and Found. Unclaimed items will be donated to charity by the DPA, throughout the year.

Parent/Guardian and Student Code of Conduct:

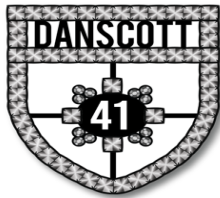
Honesty and integrity is expected at all times from Parents/Guardians and students.

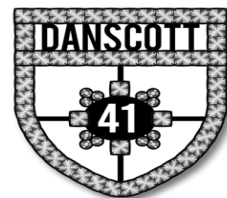
